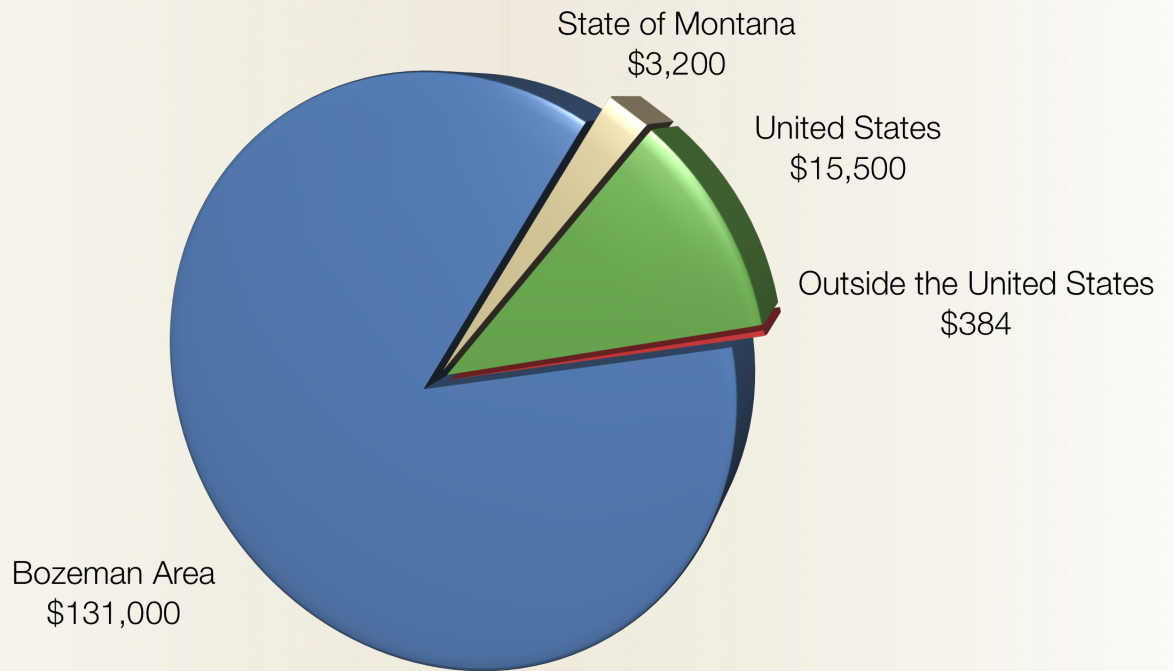

2005 Giving by Geographic Area

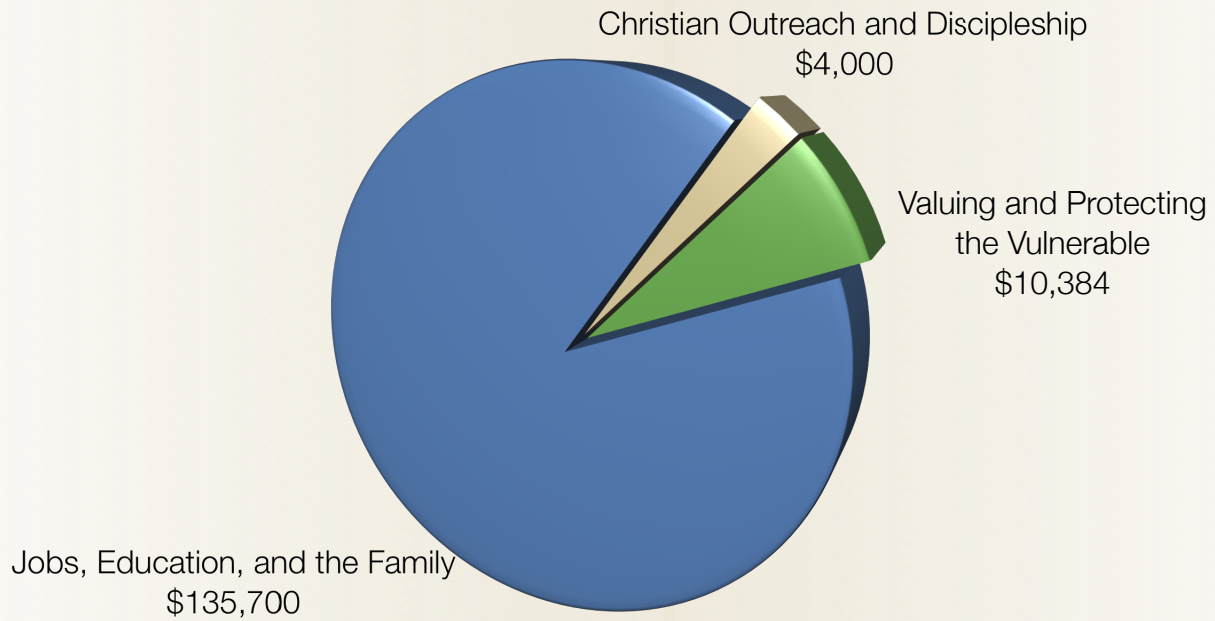

Areas of Focus
