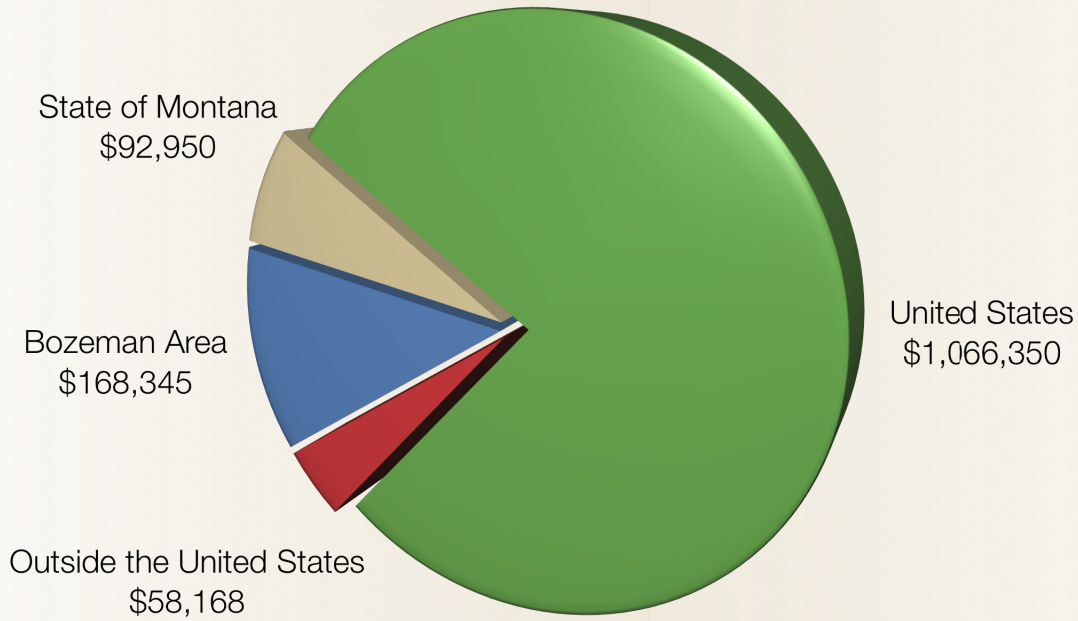

## 2007 Giving by Geographic Area

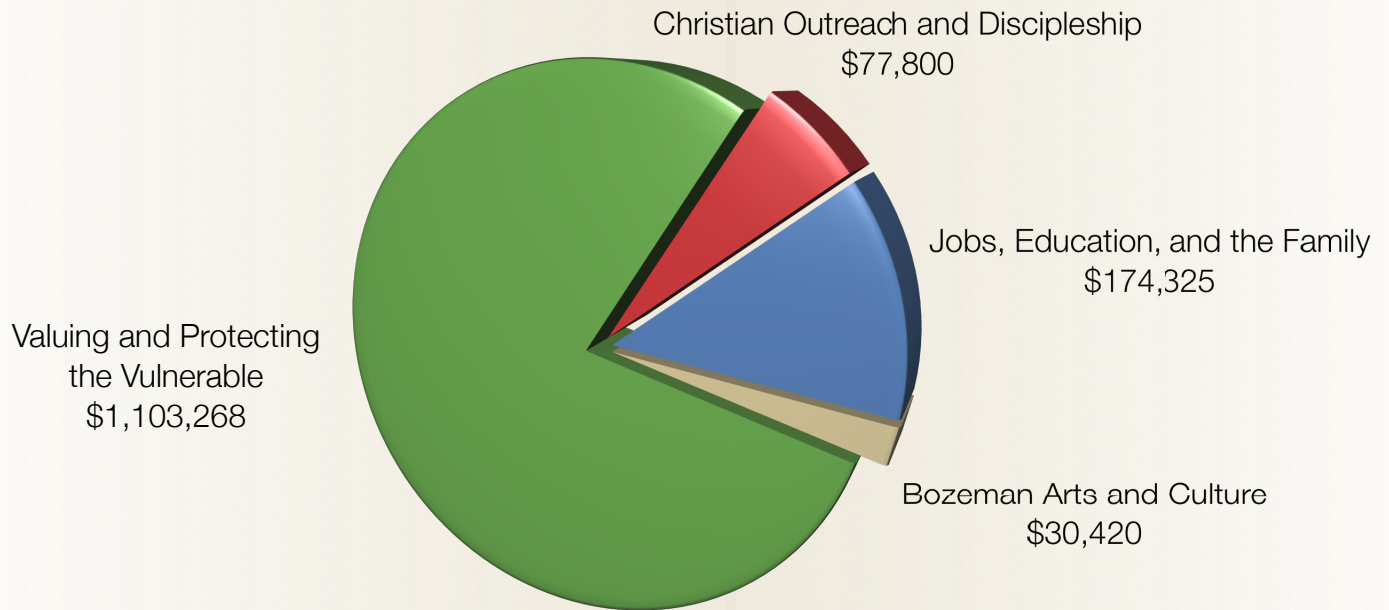

## 2007 Giving by Focus Area

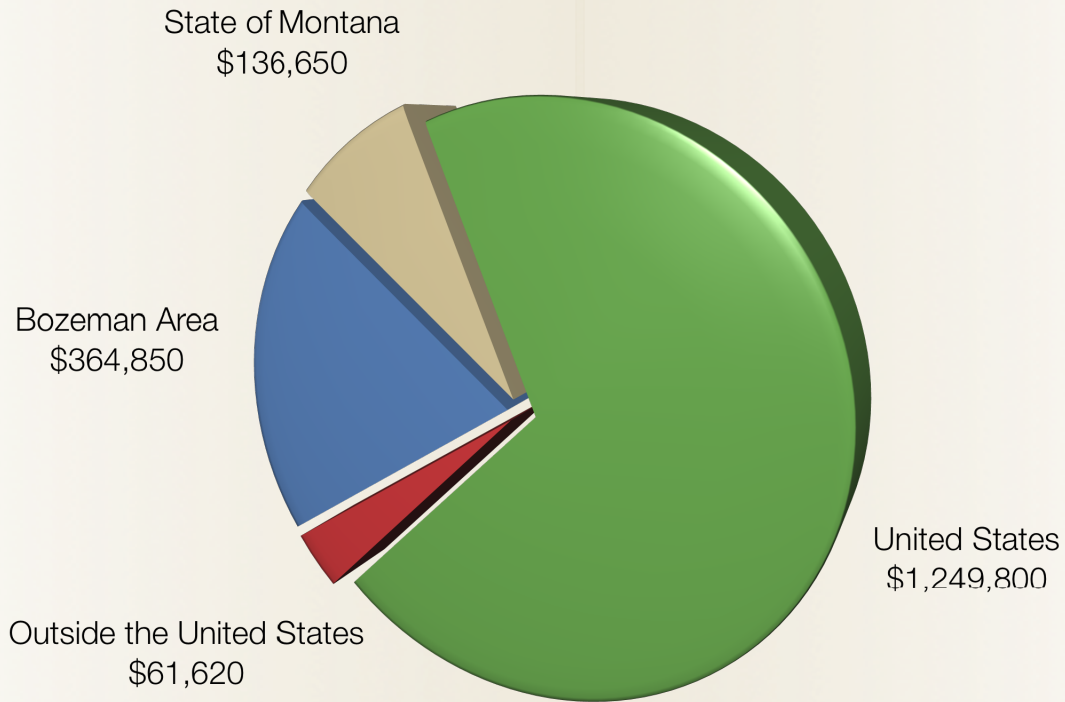

# Cumulative Giving by Geographic Area

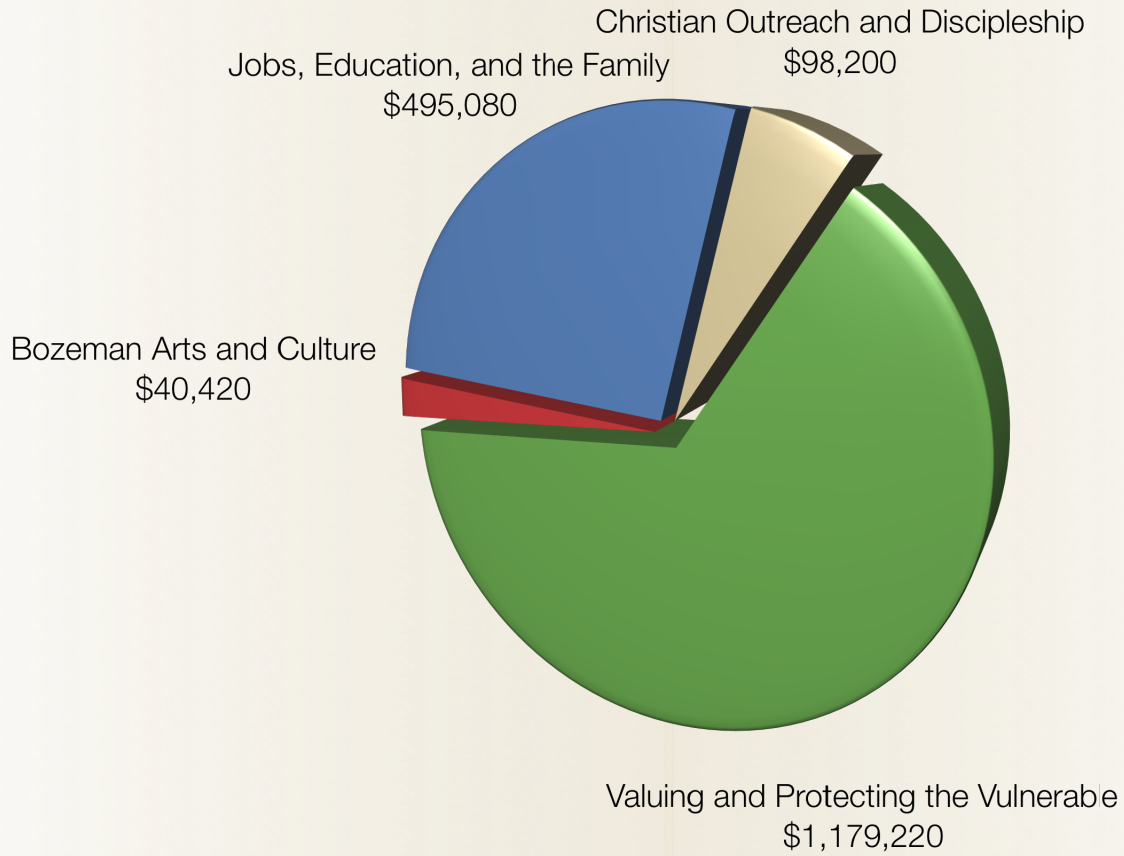

## Areas of Focus

### Jobs, Education, and the Family

### Christian Outreach and Discipleship
