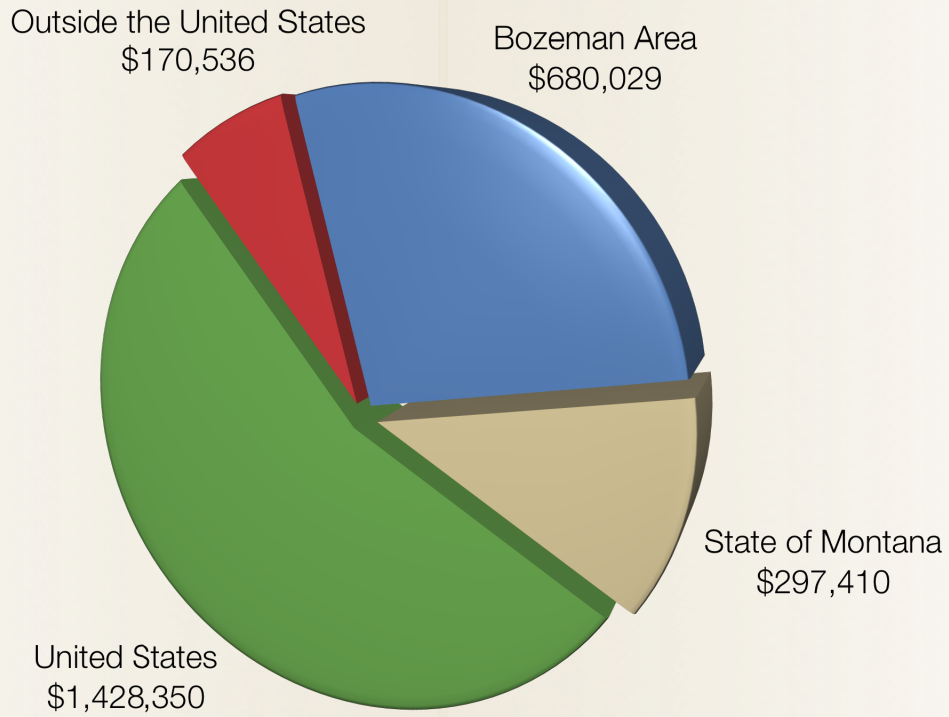
Creating lasting change...

2008 Giving by Geographic Area

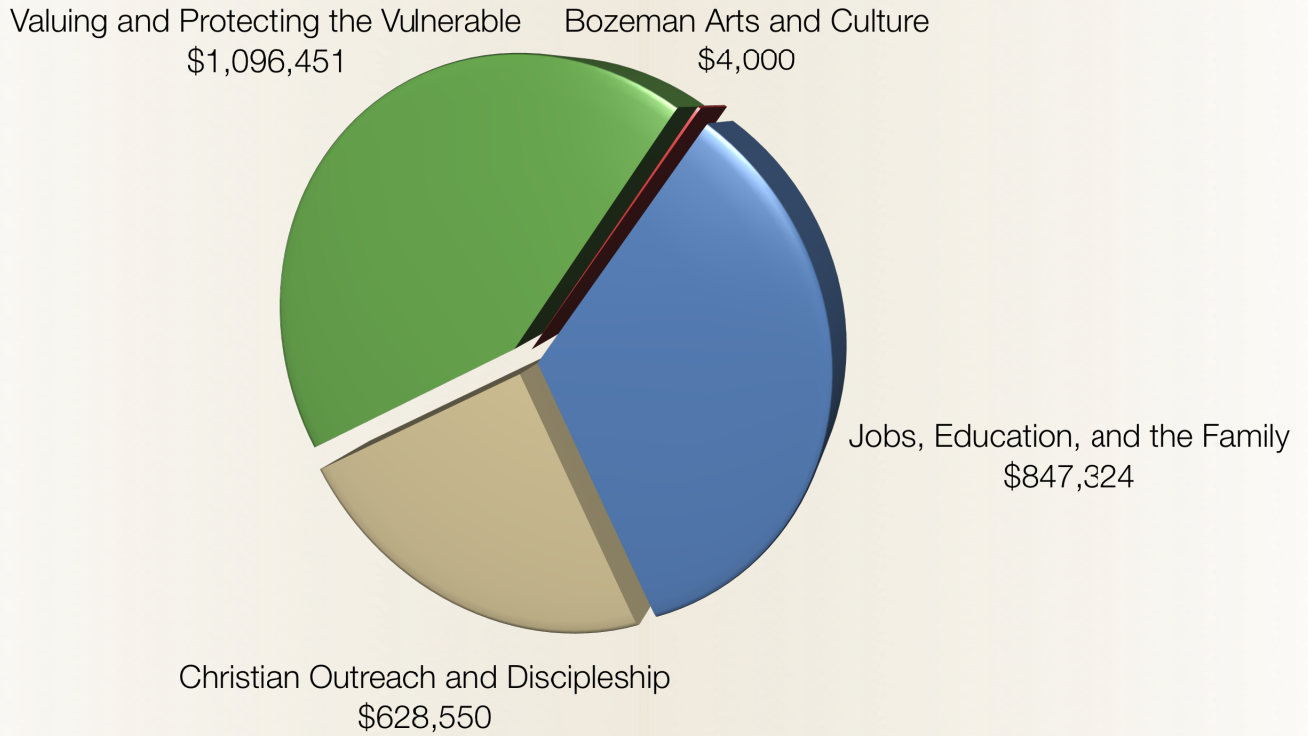

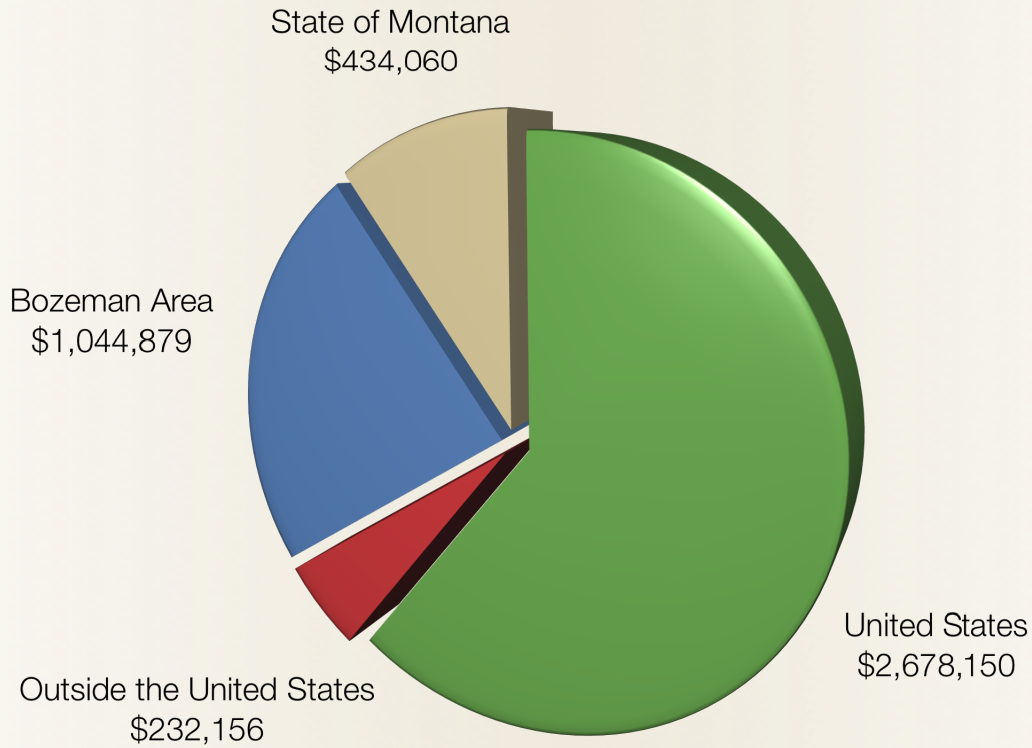
2008 Giving by Focus Area

Cumulative Giving by Geographic Area

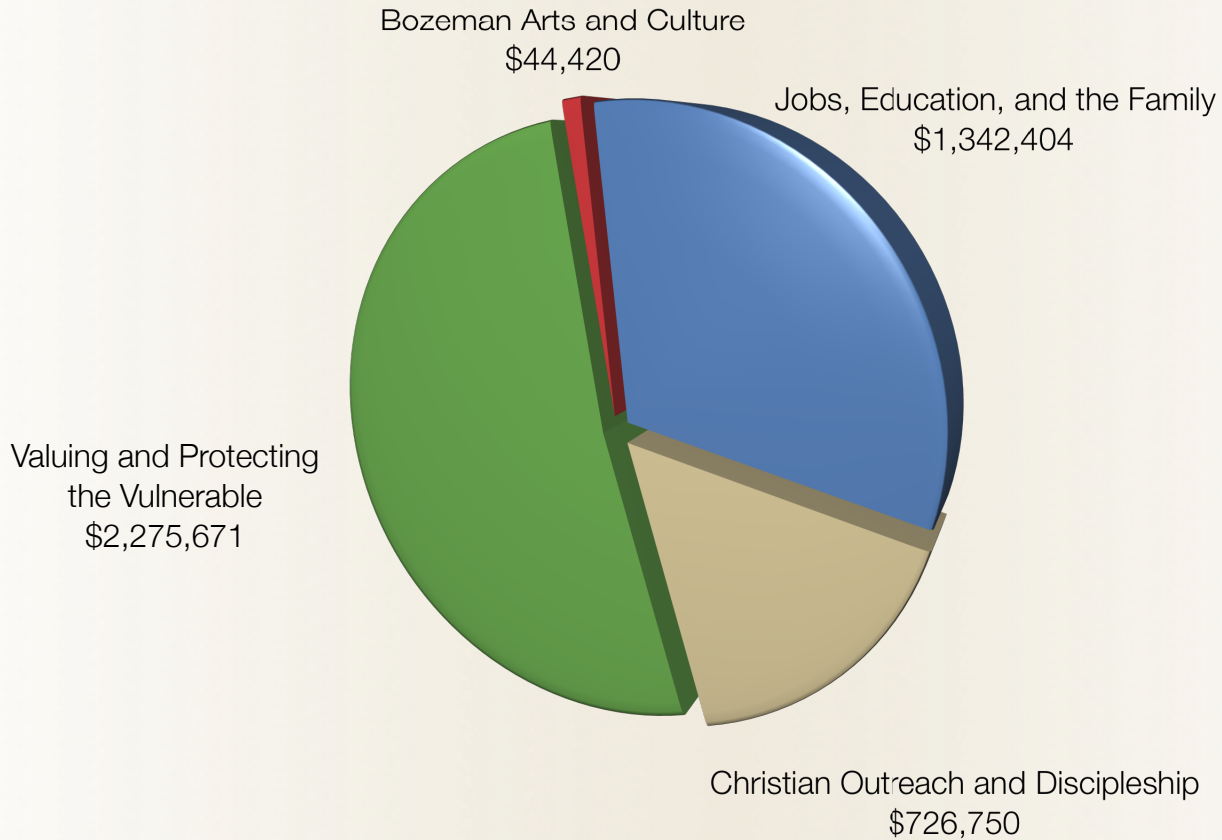

Areas of Focus

These organizations minister the Christian faith by sharing the gospel, providing discipleship, and supplying faith-based resources to individuals and families.
