


We are, as always, thankful to the many groups who are working to help those in need, and we are grateful for the opportunity to participate in the work they are doing.

# 2010 Giving by Geographic Area





# 2010 Giving by Focus Area





### Christian Outreach and Discipleship

These organizations minister the Christian faith by sharing the gospel, providing discipleship, and supplying faith-based resources to individuals and families.
