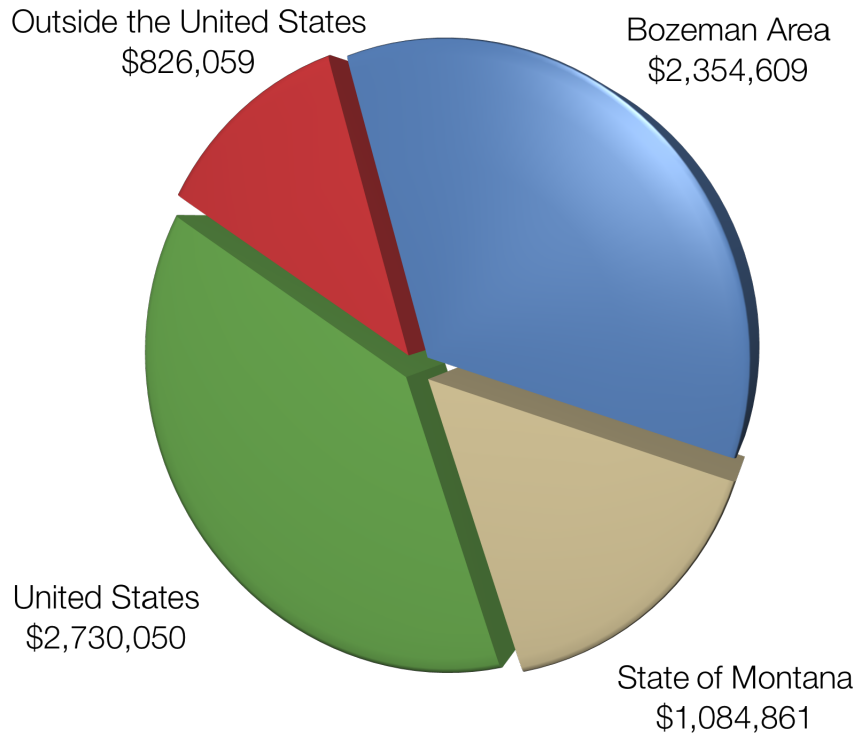

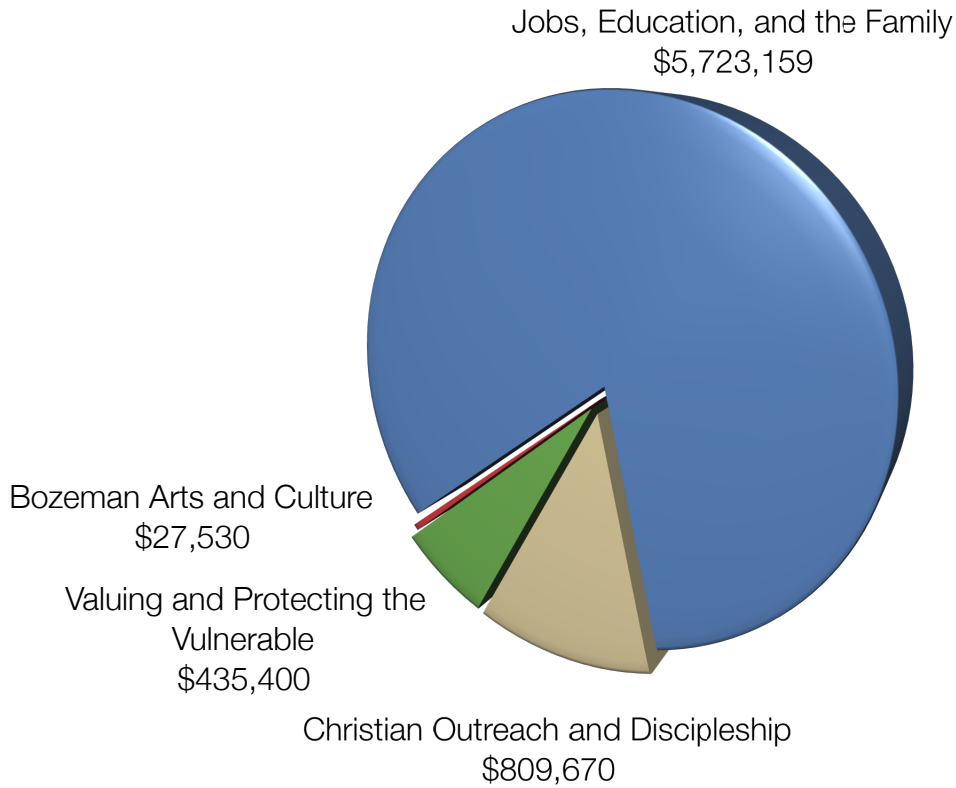
# 2012 Giving by Geographic Area

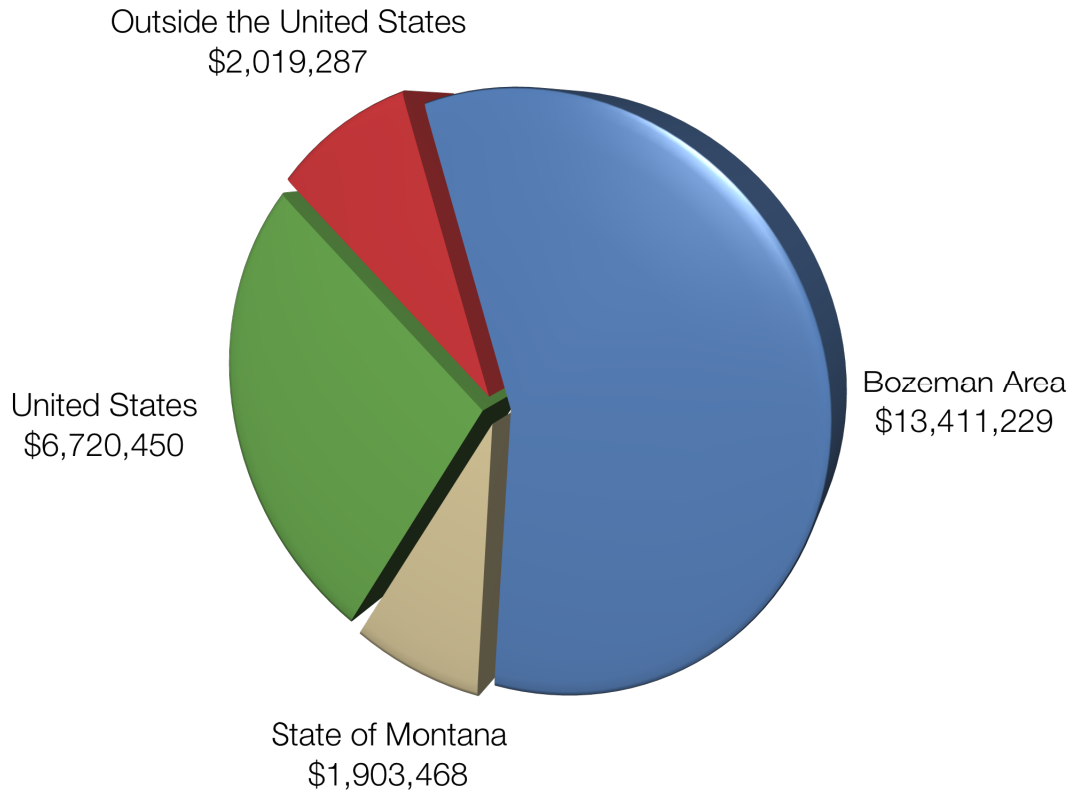

# Cumulative Giving by Geographic Area

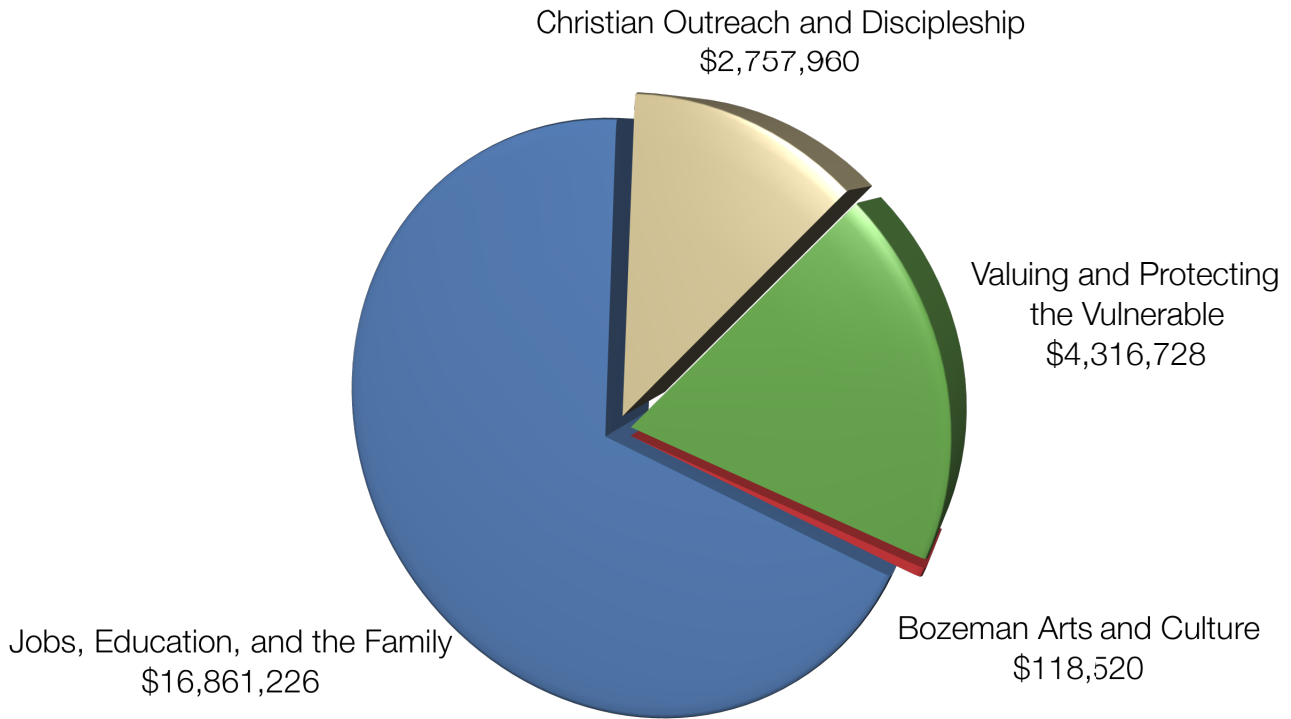
