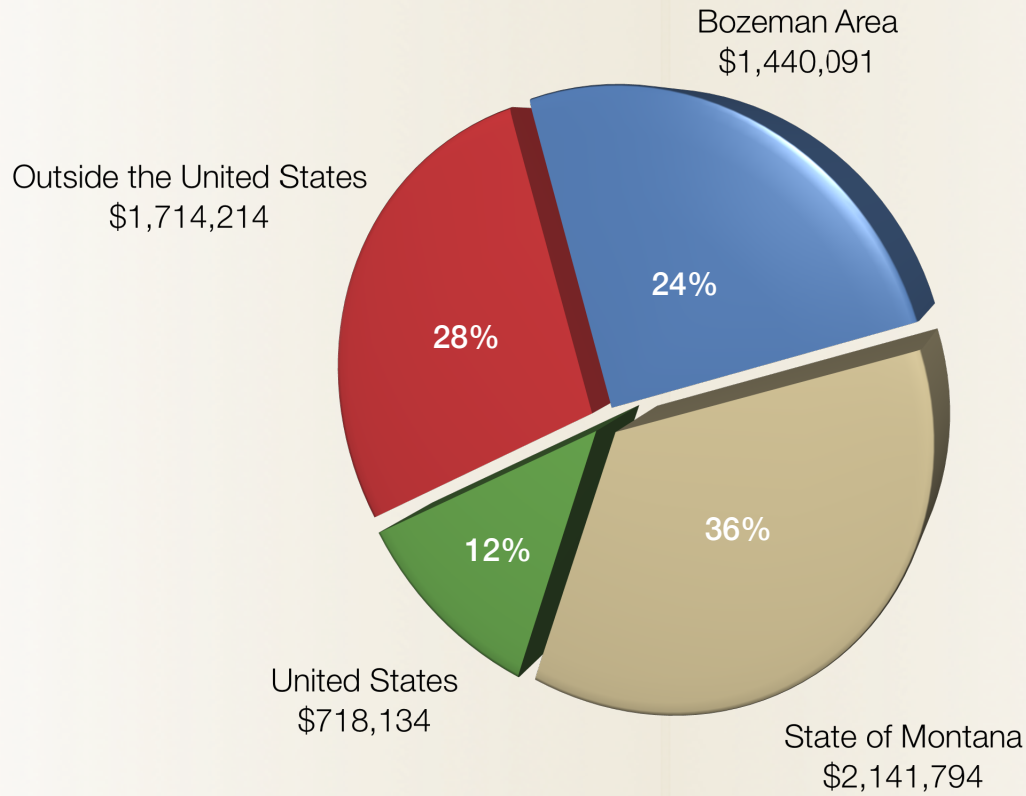
Year in Review

Once again, young people have been a major focus of this year's giving. In the area of education, millions of dollars were given to provide school buildings and scholarships for children to receive the education best suited to them, both locally and across the world. Significant funds were provided to a program that introduces local high school students to the field of computer science, and even more to an organization that brings opportunities for open discussions of truth at major universities across the country.

Close to another million dollars was provided to groups that protect vulnerable children, including a chapel building that serves hurting children and their families, pregnancy care centers that seek to care for unborn children and their parents, a group that ministers to fatherless boys, and an organization that provides opportunities for at-risk children to receive tutoring and spiritual and emotional support.

2013 Giving by Geographic Area

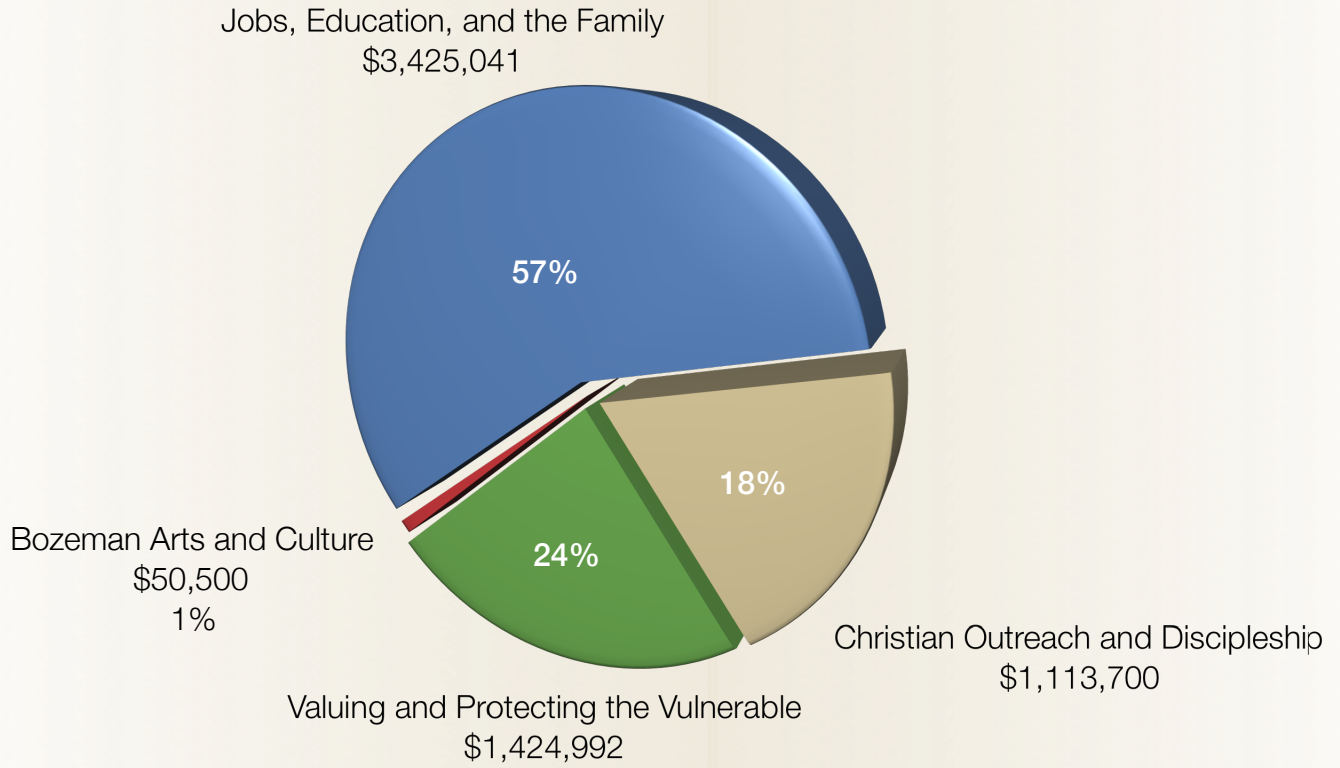

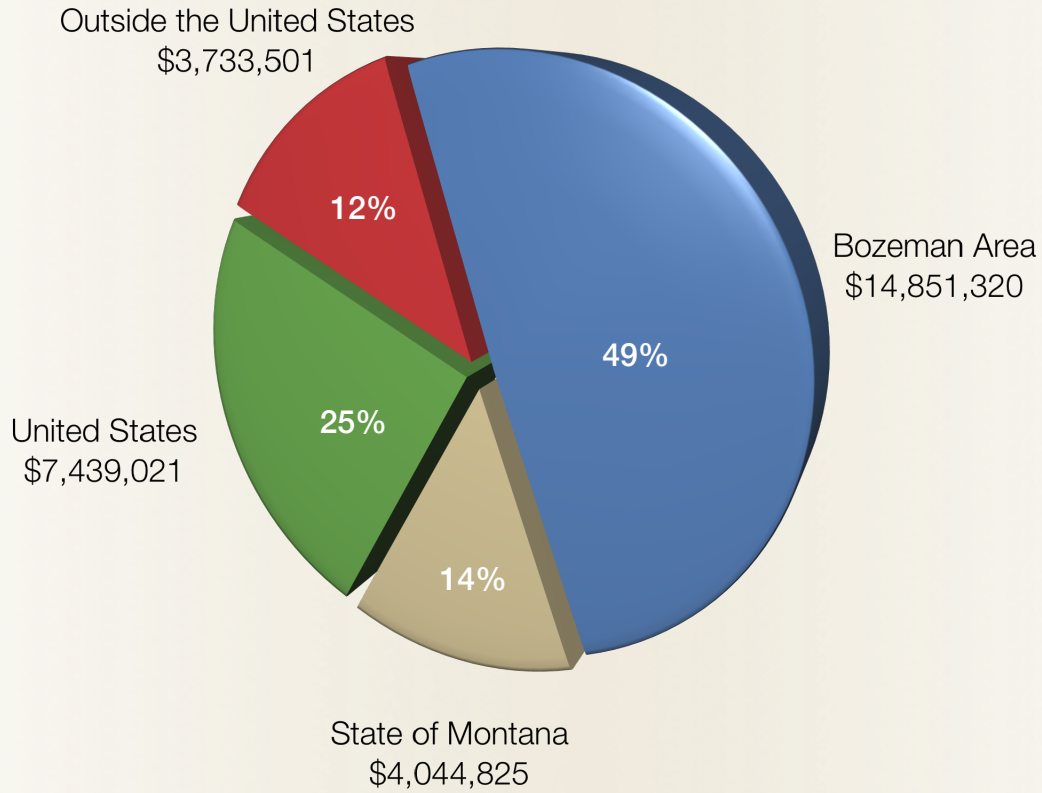
2013 Giving by Focus Area

Cumulative Giving by Geographic Area

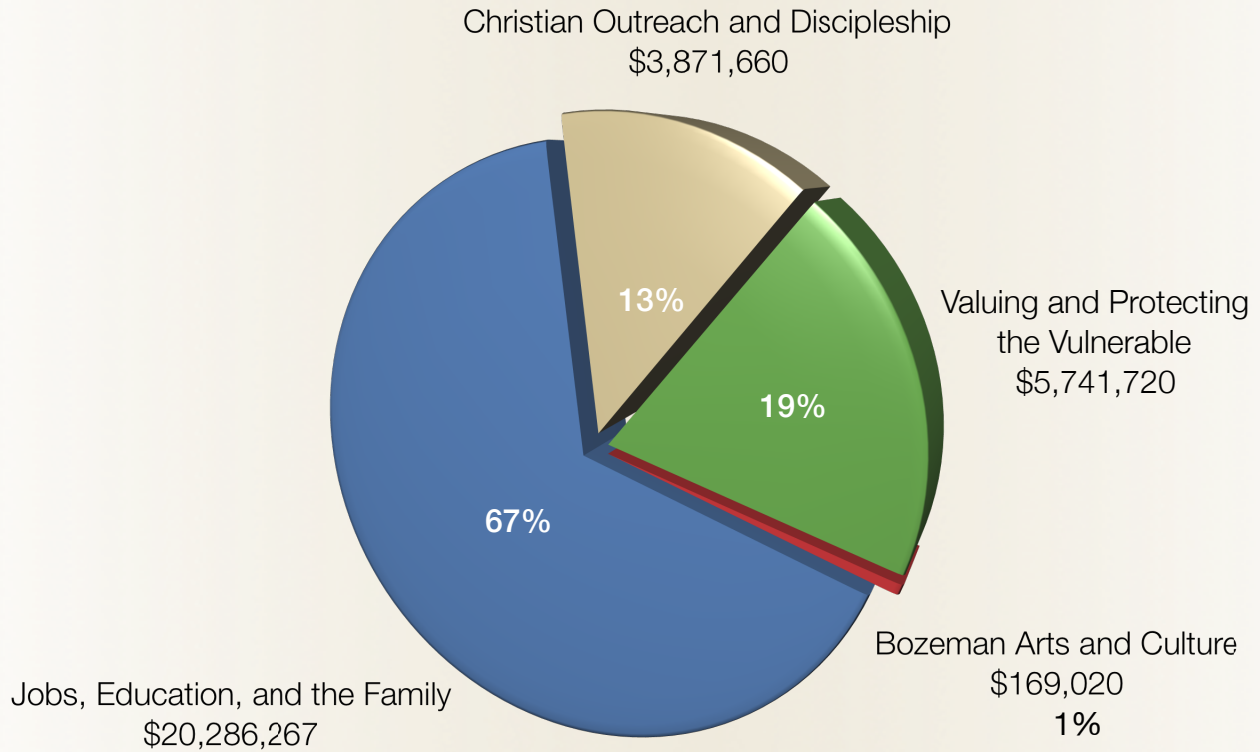
