Attached you will see both our giving for 2014 and over the lifetime of our foundation, categorized by our focus areas and the geographical reach of our partners.

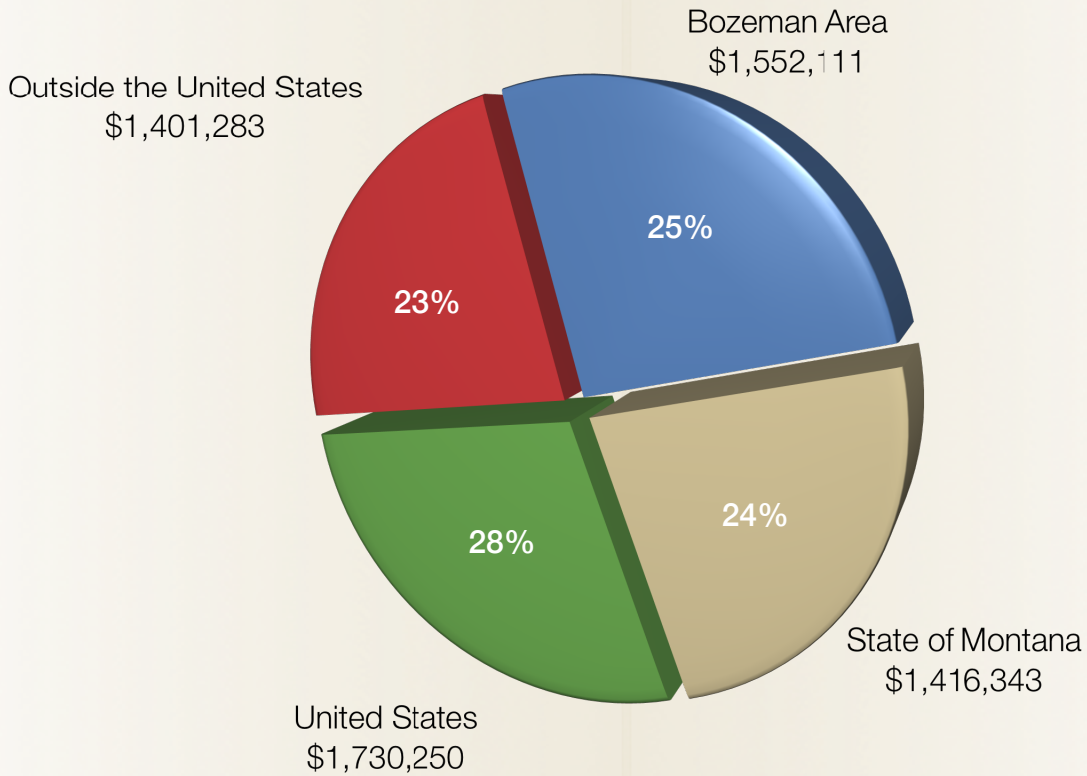

2014 Giving by Geographic Area

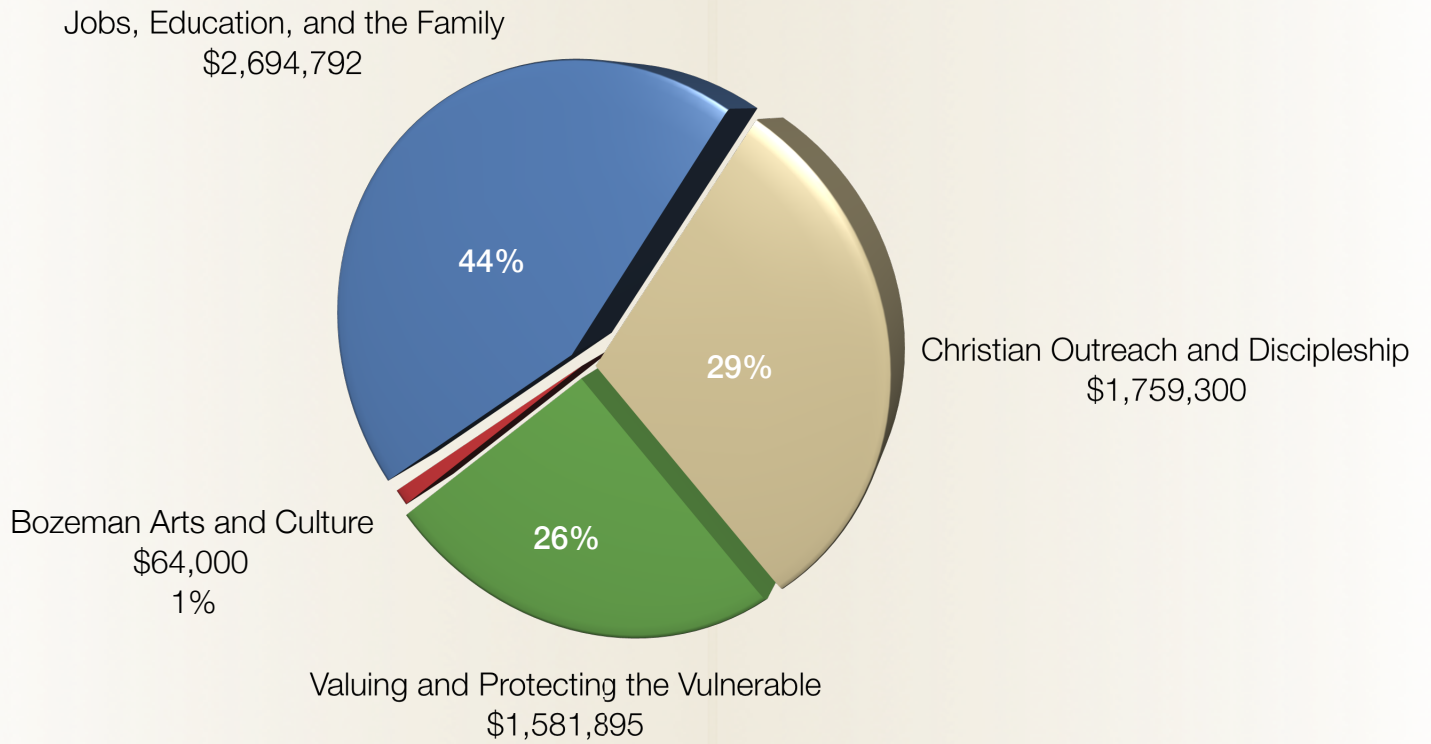

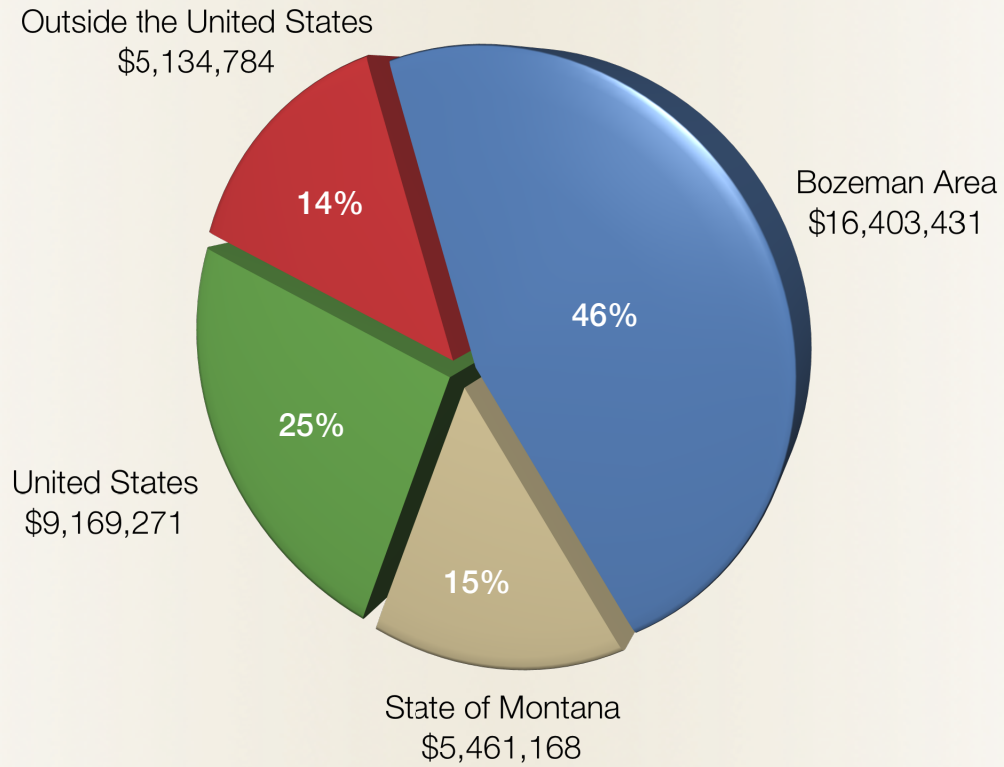
2014 Giving by Focus Area

Cumulative Giving by Geographic Area

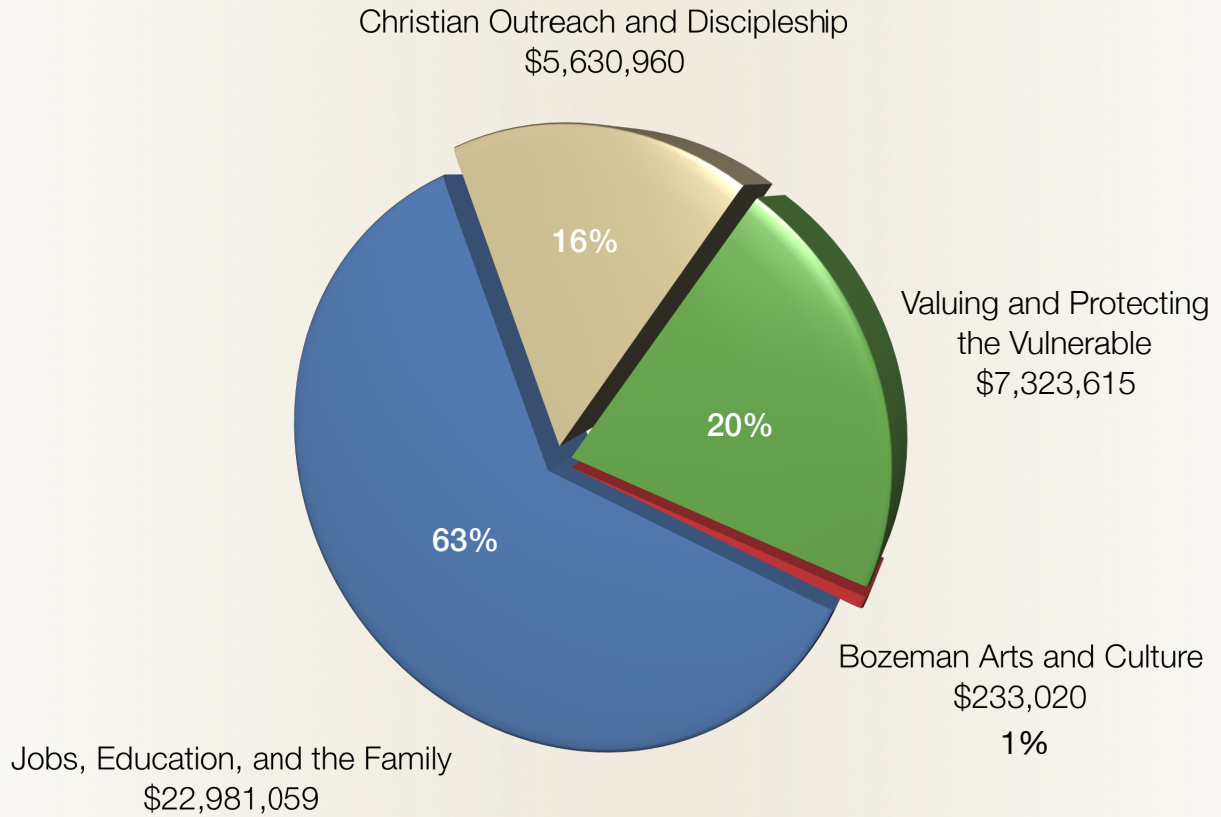

Areas of Focus

Jobs, Education, and the Family

Bozeman Arts and Culture

These organizations enhance the Bozeman community by providing local programs and cultural opportunities.

Christian Outreach and Discipleship

These organizations minister the Christian faith by sharing the gospel, providing discipleship, and supplying faith-based resources to individuals and families.
